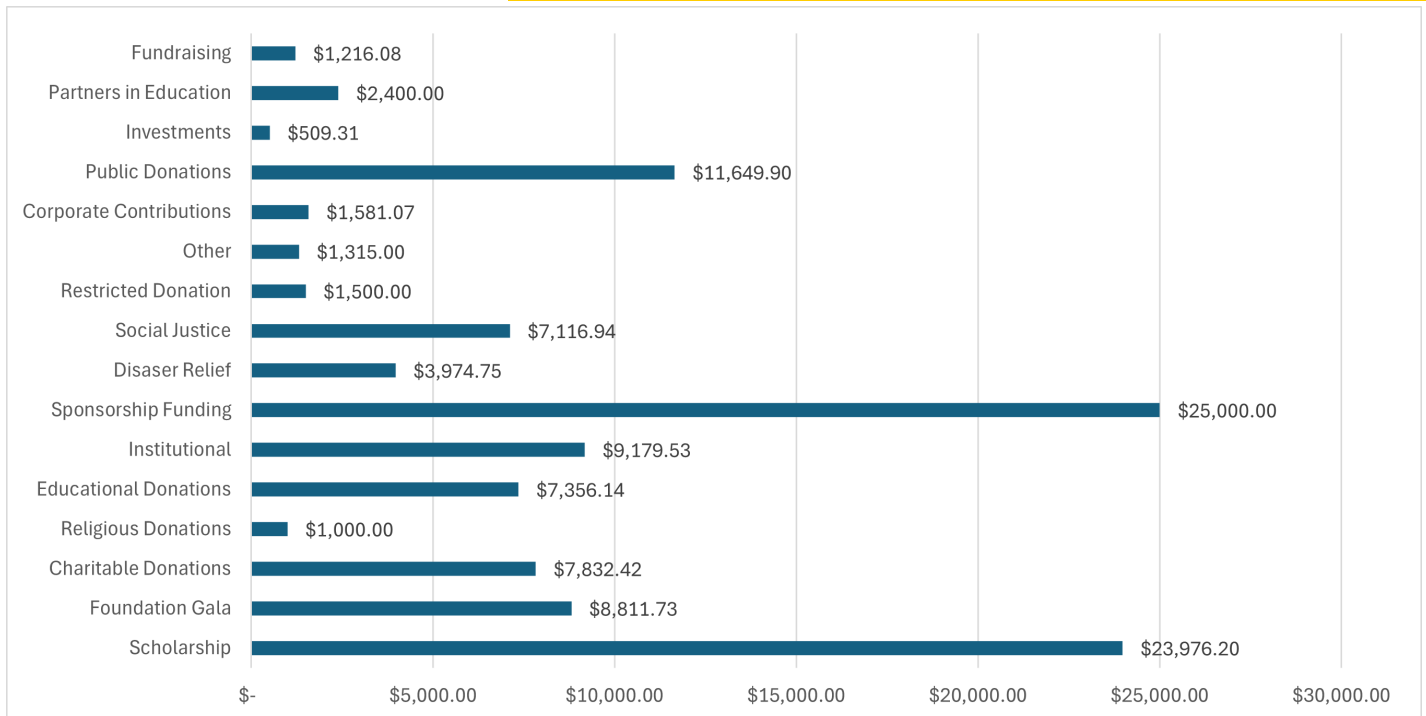

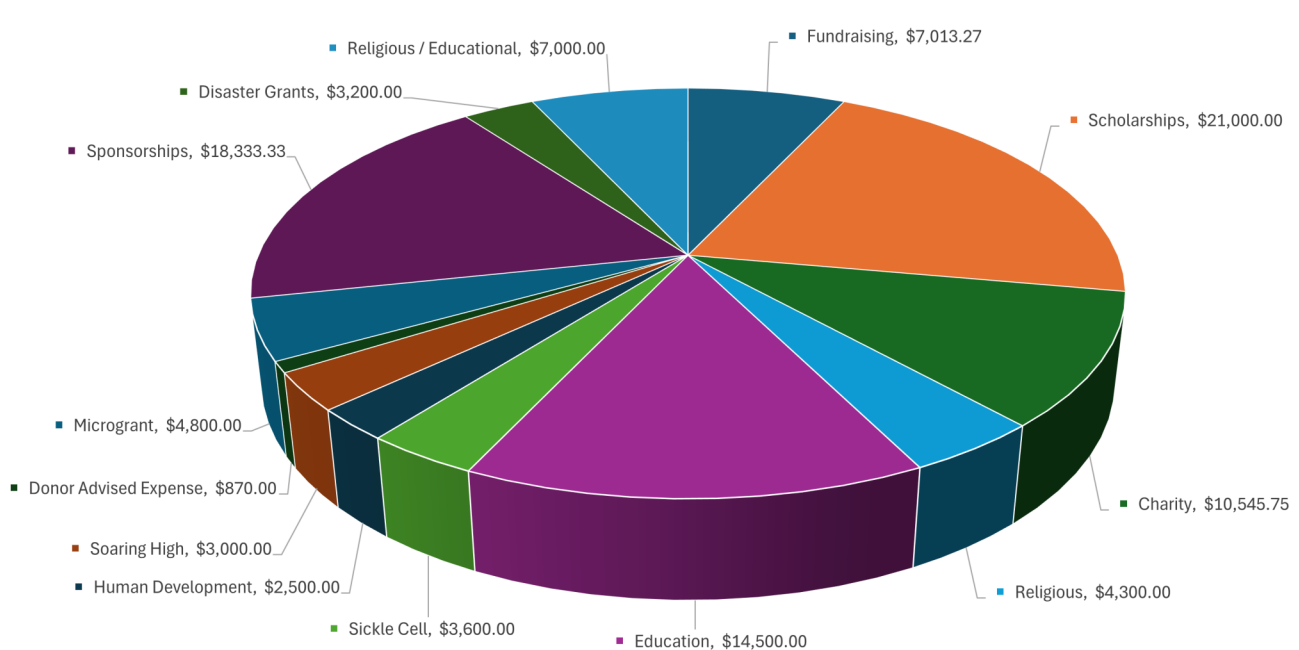

For what type (s) of programs will these funds be used?

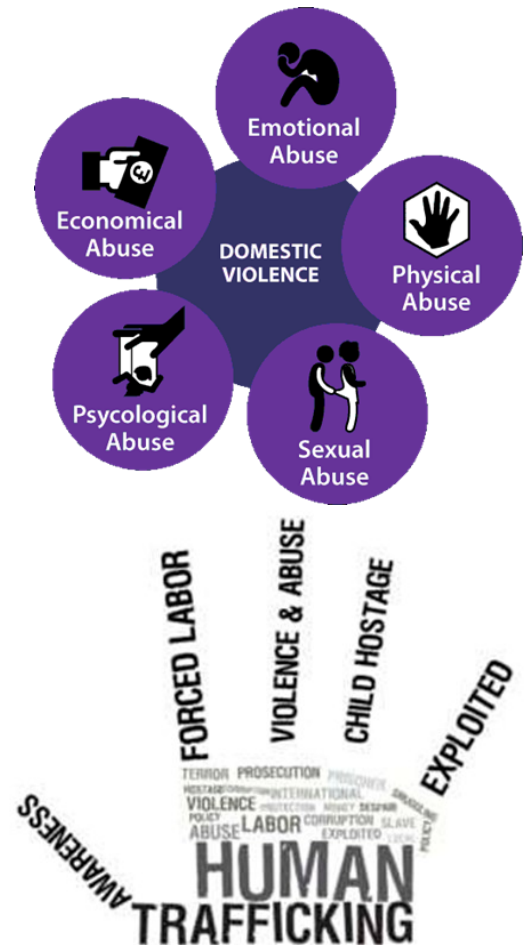
